- Industrial Waste Cell leachate was sent off site for disposal (received analytical data, shipped to new facility)

- · Performed daily ammonia monitoring
- Service and calibration performed on ammonia monitors
 - Stationary monitor near residential area removed for service to service pump. Monitor expected to be back in service on 9-16-2017.
