- Continued to ship Aluminum Processing Waste Cell leachate off-site for disposal
- Industrial Waste Cell leachate continued to be treated and stored
- Industrial Waste Cell leachate was shipped off-site for disposal
- Performed routine daily gas system operation and maintenance activities
- Performed daily ammonia monitoring
- Closure Construction Activities Performed:
 - Activities at Aluminum Processing Waste Cell:
 - Minimal work performed on the Aluminum Processing Waste Cell this week
 - Activities at Industrial Waste Cell:
 - Contractor completed installation of structural fill above rock and organic free soil
 - Contractor began installation of compacted clay liner (75% complete)
 - Surveyors on site verifying elevations of structural fill and compacted clay layer
 - General Site Construction Activities:
 - Performed installation of stormwater control components (ditch check dams, energy dissipaters)
 - Weekly construction meeting held
