NOTICE OF ISSUANCE OF A TEMPORARY EMERGENCY PERMIT TO DYNO NOBEL

The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM) has issued a temporary emergency permit to Dyno Nobel. The facility (EPA ID TNR0000051193) is in Wilson County at 2474 Chicken Rd. in Lebanon, Tennessee 37090. The permit (TNTMP-24-001) allows for temporary storage of a 30-yd container of waste generated from a roadside spill associated with EPA ID TNR000051185. The waste is coded as a characteristic hazardous waste for flammability (D001) and reactivity (D003). The permit is valid for 90 days beginning April 19, 2024, and shall terminate on July 18, 2024.

Issuing an emergency permit under Tennessee Rule 0400-12-01-.07(1)(d) was necessary because improper management of the hazardous waste could result in an imminent and substantial endangerment to human health or the environment. The emergency permit provides the benefit of allowing the waste to be stored in a controlled manner. The emergency permit is issued under the authority of the Tennessee Hazardous Waste Management Act of 1977, as amended, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-212-101 et seq., and Tennessee Rule Chapter 0400-12-01, <u>Hazardous Waste Management</u>.


