## Wastewater Treatment **Board Sanctioned Training**

This course will examine wastewater treatment facilities and the procedures used to operate a wastewater treatment plant. The student will refamiliarize themselves with wastewater treatment theories and have the opportunity to focus on content areas that were unsuccessful on the certification examination.
