Please join us for a discussion about EPA's <u>Clean Watersheds</u> <u>Needs Survey (CWNS)</u>, the only nationwide comprehensive assessment of the capital costs (or needs) to meet the water quality goals of the Clean Water Act. The results of this survey have not been updated since the 2012 CWNS Report was released in 2016, and EPA is excited to present an overview of the survey and the most recent results! <u>Register now!</u>

The survey gathers needs for projects eligible for funding through the Clean Water State Revolving Fund that address water quality and water quality related public health concerns in four major infrastructure areas: wastewater, stormwater, decentralized wastewater treatment, and nonpoint source management projects.
