A. Christian Care Center of Bristol, Bristol (Sullivan County), TN — CN1404-012A The project was unanimously approved July 23, 2014.

The relocation and replacement of a 120\* bed nursing home from 261 North Street, Bristol (Sullivan County) to 2830 Highway 394, Bristol (Sullivan County), Tennessee. The estimated project cost is \$11,953,747.00.

Request for an 18 month extension from September 1, 2016 to March 1, 2018.
