
Proficiency testing (PT) is the testing of unknown samples sent to a laboratory by a CMS-approved PT program. PT referral is where one laboratory refers their PT samples to another laboratory for testing. PT is important because it is a tool the laboratory can use to verify the accuracy and reliability of its testing.

PT is required for non-waived testing found in Subpart I of the CLIA regulations. PT is not required for waived testing but IF A LABORATORY ENROLLS IN PT FOR WAIVED TESTING, ALL REGULATIONS RELATED TO PT REFERRAL APPLY.

Laboratories that receive PT samples from another lab are required to report the incident to the CLIA State Agency. <u>DO NOT TEST THE SAMPLES</u>. Refer to the PT brochure below for the three categories for PT referral.

PT results should NEVER be sent to another laboratory <u>BEFORE OR AFTER</u> the PT event cut-off date.
