Representative Hawk asked if DHS is doing any similar work as the Atlanta Federal Reserve Bank. Suzanne Carr answered affirmatively that DHS is working on similar projects internally and across other Departments utilizing similar tools and No Wrong Door programs. She reiterated that the focus of the DHS pilot will be the benefits cliff.

Michelle Joyner discussed the DHS MOU with the Atlanta Federal Reserve Bank which would give DHS the capacity to integrate the benefits cliff tool into frontline staff services. This tool will be available to other pilots as well.
