## 35 Fall from truck tailgate – Inspection 1256444

A 39 year old male employee was fatally injured when he fell from a moving truck while riding on the tailgate. On the day of the incident, three employees had finished their lunch break and were going back to their work location to continue weed-eating. Two employees got into the cab of the Chevrolet 1500 work truck and the victim sat on the tailgate. As they were in route to their work location, the driver looked into the rear-view mirror and saw the victim lying on the ground. The truck had traveled approximately 150 yards. The investigation revealed that the most likely scenario was that the victim was riding on the tailgate of the truck when he fell and his head contacted the asphalt ground.
